Animal People is the new collection by distinguished poet Carol Rumens. The key to the collection is the sequence “On the Spectrum”™, which explores what it is to be “on the autistic spectrum”™. Drawing on personal and family experience, this poem is infused with the author’s characteristic empathy, curiosity and humanity. There is a strong sense of commemoration in this collection, of time passing and of the challenges of mortality, and also a number of brilliant pieces that are influenced by translations or re-readings of classic works of literature.
