

The four gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John show the life and teachings of Jesus Christ. Here the four-column format shows in detail how well, and in which areas, these documents parallel each other. Not a single detail, order of events or word has been changed, revealing that the gospels are already in agreement with each other on shared dates and events. This parallelism may not be surprising, given that the synoptic gospels (Matthew, Mark and Luke) are believed to share a common source(s), however the gospel of John also fits perfectly in with this framework, despite often covering or focusing on different events. This book will be useful for anyone wishing to study the life of Christ in detail, to compare the gospels, or merely wishing to appreciate the New Testament from a slightly different angle.

The gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke are referred to as the Synoptic Gospels because they include many of the same stories, often in a similar sequence and in similar or sometimes identical wording. They stand in contrast to John, whose content is comparatively distinct.

The four gospels that we find in the New Testament, are of course, Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. The first three of these are usually referred to as the synoptic gospels, because they look at things in a similar way, or they are similar in the way that they tell the story.
